The RISD Board of Trustees has called a bond election in the amount of \$37,302,581.

What is included in the proposed bond package?

The bond proposal impacts every campus & addresses capacity, growth, safety measures, and aging infrastructure.

How fast is the Royal ISD growing?

A demographics study shows that, conservatively, the Royal ISD could add 1,800+ new students between 2020-2030.

How will passage of the bond election affect my taxes?

Financial advisors forecast no tax rate increase if any (or all) of the bond propositions are approved by voters.
