

Last year, First Service Credit Union lost a dear friend and co-worker, Wendy Kwan. She was a bright, vivacious, dedicated and talented woman. She was also a mother, expecting a second child.

Wendy, who was only 34, died from an undetected brain aneurism. The doctors were only able to save her unborn daughter, Olivia, through emergency surgery. Out of our love for Wendy and her family, the employees of First Service Credit Union came together to form the You First Foundation. The foundation's purpose is to support neurointensive care and neurointensive recovery centers to further their research on brain injuries and recovery solutions. The You First Foundation will also help the families of brain injury victims through scholarships.

## **Economic Development Committee Meeting**

The Economic Development Committee met on Thursday, August 20 at the offices of the Brookshire Drying Co. We were treated to a very interesting and informative tour and demonstration by Pam Wostarek, Manager. Attendees from the West I-10 Chamber were Corrine Vahalik, Arnold England, Bill Fry, Commissioner Justin Beckendorff, and Greg Turner.

The Brookshire Drying Co. was founded in 1948 by local farmers and entrepreneurs, whose families remain active in its ownership. The company employs seven persons full time, as well as additional part time workers. Pam, originally from Mississippi, has been employed at the facility since 1993. Her duties include not only responsibility for drying and storing rice, but also monitoring quality and helping sell rice to the processing mills in the Houston region.

Locally, about 5,400 acres of land are farmed with rice. In Texas, 107 thousand acres were farmed last year, down from 140 thousand in 2013. Issues affecting pricing include the weather, the strength of the dollar (it is a global industry), quality, and government controls.

Ms. Wostarek described how more farming is done today on fewer acres, due to technology that increases yields. An example of this is the second crop. The first crop, harvested generally in July, was formerly about three times larger than the second crop brought in at October harvest time, but nowadays the second crop yield is close to the first.

The Economic Development Committee is grateful to Pam Wostarek for opening the doors of the Brookshire Drying Co. facilities to us for one of the best presentations we have seen.

Senator Lois W. Kolkhorst is a fifth-generation Texan, with ancestral roots to the Texas War of Independence. A Brenham native, she went on to graduate from TCU where she played collegiate golf.

In December 2014, Kolkhorst was elected to the Texas Senate in a special election, after previously serving fourteen years in the Texas House. Recognized as a fiscal conservative, she is a member of the Senate Finance Committee, and has served three times on the state's budget conference-committee, most recently during the final negotiations on the states \$209 billion budget passed in 2015. She also serves as Vice-Chair of the Senate Committee on Health and Human Services and has written landmark legislation to toughen Texas laws on medical privacy. She earned statewide attention for crafting alternatives to Obamacare for healthcare providers.

Senator Kolkhorst is a member of the Senate Committee on Education, and is considered a longtime friend to parents and teachers as well as colleges and universities. Representing all or part of twenty-one Texas counties, she serves on the Senate Transportation Committee as well as the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Water and Rural Affairs, drafting many laws to protect private property rights.
