Attendees at the December 8th membership luncheon welcomed its newest member and were treated to an overview of the new Texas Children's West Cam-

pus under construction at Interstate 10 and Barker Cypress Road by Pete Dawson AIA, Sr. VP of Facilities Services at Texas Children's Hospital and Kara Borg-

meyer, Financial & Special Projects Coordinator. West Campus, Houston's first community hospital designed, built and staffed for children, will be among the nation's largest suburban pediatric hospitals and will serve one of the country's fastest growing child populations. The hospital has been designed to incorporate the best practices in pediatric treatment environments and to provide the special accommodations that families need in a children's medical facility. The medical campus is being built in phases, totaling 534,000 square feet, with the outpatient clinic building and the inpatient facility scheduled to open in late 2010. Texas Children's Hospital is one of the largest pediatric hospitals in the U.S. and is renowned worldwide for its expertise and breakthrough developments in clinical care and research. Texas Children's Hospital West Campus will provide easy access to the same unsurpassed standard of care for which Texas Children's Hospital is internationally recognized.
